Round 5 of the 2022 Championships

Hello Racers,

Attendance was a bit down on expectations with F600s being represented the best with 8 racers and there being 4 in the Club 500s and only 3 in each of the Wacky and Mono 1 races.

Fortunately the weather was with us and water conditions were favourable. However the old enemy, the blanket weed, yet once again presented a headache, but with some skilled driving from Tim, him and I were able to clear a good amount of it from the course and we were able to run our normal race courses during the day.

Tony and his crew of able bodied workers were able to complete work on the pontoon before racing started and this certainly made access to the starting gates a lot safer and easier. Although the access is a bit steep Tony has a plan to rectify this and in the near future this will then be "A1".

As a result of the weed and work on the pontoon the start of racing was delayed but once started we were able to complete rounds 1 and 2 of the Club 500 and F600s before lunch. The afternoon session saw completion of all the other rounds of the Club 500, F600, Wacky and Mono 1 races.

A brief summary of the results were as follows:

CLUB 500 - 1st Tim K with a score of 18 laps and 56 seconds, 2nd Colin M with 17 laps and 37 seconds, 3rd Leo D with 16 laps and 22 seconds.

F600B - 1st Tim K with a score of 26 laps and 27 seconds, 2nd Paul G with 26 laps and 34 seconds, 3rd Alan W with 25 laps and 31 seconds.

Wacky Racers - 1st Dave P with 44 laps and 37 seconds, 2nd Tim K with 39 laps and 12 seconds, 3rd Leo D with 23 laps and 39 seconds.

Mono 1 - 1st Dave P with 58 laps and 19 seconds, 2nd Tim K with 57 laps and 24 seconds, 3rd Leo D with 44 laps and 24 seconds.
