

## MTMBC Fast Electric News, Results and Reports

### Round 6 of the 2022 Championships

Hello Racers,

Attendance was again down with the F600s being represented the best with 5 racers and there being 3 in each of the Club 500s, the Wacky's and the Mono 1's.

Fortunately the weather was with us and water conditions were favourable. However the old enemy, the blanket weed was present but was a lot better than previous races and Tony and Steve saw to clearing the bits that had raised their ugly heads.

As a result of the weed the start of racing was a bit delayed but once started we were able to complete all rounds of the Club 500s and F600s before lunch. The afternoon session saw completion of the Wacky and Mono 1 races. We ran a rectangular for the day due to there was a lot of weed in the middle of the buoys.

Things ran really smoothly and the racing was really close as the brief summary of the results below show.

A summary of the results are as follows:

**CLUB 500** - 1st Tim K with a score of 18 laps and 12 seconds, 2nd Colin M with 18 laps and 42 seconds, 3rd Steve G with 16 laps and 45 seconds.

**F600B** - 1st Paul G with a score of 30 laps and 41 seconds, 2nd Tim K with 30 laps and 42 seconds, 3rd Colin M with 29 laps and 14 seconds.

**Wacky Racers** - 1st Dave P with 48 laps and 43 seconds, 2nd Tim K with 41 laps and 3 seconds, 3rd Steven G with 35 laps and 39 seconds.

**Mono 1** - 1st Tim K with 63 laps and 14 seconds, 2nd Dave P with 60 laps and 19 seconds, 3rd Steve G with 56 laps and 32 seconds.
