Round 8 of the 2023 Championship

Hello Racers

F600B - Race 1st Paul G (25 laps/16 seconds), 2nd Leo D (25 laps/22 seconds) and 3rd Wiki D (25 laps/33 seconds). Championship 1st Paul G (54 pts), 2nd Leo D (37 pts) and 3rd Wiki D (19 pts)

WACKY RACERS - Race 1st Tim K (42 laps/17 seconds), 2nd Steve G (42 laps/20 seconds) and 3rd Leo D (38 laps/20 seconds). Championship 1st Tim K (45 pts), 2nd Steve G (21 pts) and 3rd Jason C-W (18 pts).

MONO1 - Race 1st Tim K (59 laps/14 seconds), 2nd Steve G (52 laps/11 seconds) and 3rd Leo D (51laps/14 seconds). Championship 1st Tim K (45 pts), 2nd Steve G (26 pts) and 3rd Dave P (12 pts)
