Victoria Class Yachts

MTMBC Rules for racing and yacht construction/specification.

Adopted by the Victoria Yacht Skippers from the beginning of the 2011 Racing Season.

RACING RULES:

A penalty turn is not required if a yacht touches a buoy. Otherwise we follow the usual MTMBC rules of yacht racing as applied to all other classes.

BOAT SPECIFICATION:

- 1. The steering wheels may be left off.
- 2. The black winches may be left off or rounded off so that the sheets do not catch on them.
- 3. The cockpit rope bushing can be replaced with a pulley.
- 4. A pulley can be attached to the end of the winch servo arm.
- 5. The boat can be strengthened if considered necessary.
- 6. Additional waterproofing is allowed, e.g. rubber bellows on the rudder pushrod.
- 7. The silver ring may be replaced with another ring of similar size.
- 8. Jib leech lines may be added.
- 9. The wire rings holding the mainsail to the mast may be replaced with larger rings or thread.
- 10. Deck eyelets may be replaced with metal ones.
- 11. The kicking strap may be modified.

General Rules:

- A. Shrouds and stays should be as in the kit.
- B. The boat may not be lightened.
- C. The kit sails must not be replaced.
- D. The triangular fitting near the top of the mast to be retained.
